Jeff Connolly is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of the Siemens group in the Australia Pacific region, the first Australian to hold this position since 1984. He reports directly to the Siemens AG Managing Board.

Jeff's 30-year career in Siemens has given him direct involvement in all areas of the Siemens portfolio as well as broad intercultural business experiences throughout Australia, Europe and Asia; most significantly he has lived and worked in China for a total of seven years. Between 2009 and 2012 he was CFO of Siemens North East Asia based in Beijing and responsible for more than 80 manufacturing companies, employing approx 40,000 people, generating a turnover of approximately A\$9 billion.

Originally from Melbourne, Jeff is a graduate of Melbourne University, and has completed the general management program of Duke University USA. He is member of the Australian Institute of Company Directors, National Trustee of CEDA, founding member of the Australian Advanced Manufacturing Council, President of the Ai Group Victoria and National Vice President (Victoria) to the Ai Group National Council, Director of the German-Australian Chamber of Industry and Commerce, member of the Victorian Government Future Industries Ministerial Advisory Council, Director of the European Australian Business Council, member of the Business Council of Australia, member of the Prime Minister / Chancellor German-Australian Bilateral Advisory Group, Chairman of the Prime Minister's Industry 4.0 Task Force, Director of the Sunshine Coast University Hospital PPP, and Director of the New Bendigo Hospital PPP.

Siemens has been active in the Pacific region for over 140 years. The Siemens Group has interests in turnover in the region of approximately A\$2 billion and provides employment to 2,200 people. Siemens' local financial commitment, via local equity, and in debt and equity participation in public infrastructure, is approximately A\$1 billion.

When Mark first moved West, he was struck by the magnificent climate, the unique natural environment and the opportunity that Western Australia provided to its people. He benefited from those opportunities and was determined to give something back to the home that had given him so much. Mark had an ambition to do what he could to make his local community, and Western Australia, a better place to live for all WA families.

This led to his work in local and state government.

In the years since his election to the Western Australian Parliament, Mark has held many senior portfolios in both Government and Opposition.

He was Parliamentary Secretary to former Premier Geoff Gallop and has served as a Minister in the portfolios of Education and Training; Environment; Racing and Gaming; Tourism and South West.

In recent years, Mark has served as Manager of Opposition Business, as well as Shadow Minister for State Development; and Planning and Housing.

He was elected Leader of the Opposition on 23 January 2012 and chose to retain responsibility for the portfolios of Regional Development, Economic Reform and Public Sector Management.

In the 2017 State Election, WA Labor won 41 Legislative Assembly seats and Mark became the 30th Premier of Western Australia.

Professor Deborah Terry was appointed Curtin University's Vice-Chancellor in February 2014 and is a Fellow and the immediate past President of the Academy of Social Sciences in Australia (ASSA), as well as Deputy Chair of the Board of Universities Australia. She is also on the Board of the Australian Research Council, Committee for Perth, St Hilda's Anglican School, Australia and New Zealand School of Government and AARNET, the provider of Australia's network infrastructure for education and research, and a past Chair of the Australian Council of Learned Academies and the Australian Research Council's College of Experts in the Social, Behavioural and Economic Sciences.

Professor Terry completed her PhD in Social Psychology at the Australian National University in Canberra. She had a distinguished career at the University of Queensland, initially as an internationally recognised scholar in psychology, before progressing through a number of senior leadership roles, including Senior Deputy Vice-Chancellor. She was made an Officer in the General Division of the Order of Australia (AO), the country's highest honours system for achievement and service, in June 2015 for distinguished service to education in the tertiary sector.

Simone is the State Labor Member for Fremantle, and the Minister for Child Protection; Women's Interests; Prevention of Family and Domestic Violence and Community Services.

Simone is passionate about Fremantle, with a particular focus on quality public schools for local families, long-term transport planning, and the economic revitalisation of our port city.

As a Minister in the McGowan Labor Government, Simone is working to establish a whole-of-government approach to tackling the scourge of family and domestic violence, and is ensuring that our state invests in children during the critical early years to build stronger families and communities.

Simone has served as the Member for Fremantle since the 2013 State Election. During her first term, Simone worked with local schools to fight education cuts, campaigned with local residents to stop the ill-conceived Perth Freight Link, and worked across the community to tackle the challenges facing our town centre.

Simone was raised by her single mother who worked while supporting her five children. Her father had multiple sclerosis and was a long-standing activist in the disability rights movement.

Prior to her election, Simone worked in the union movement for over 22 years. She was one of the first women elected to be an Organiser for the Australian Manufacturing Workers Union, before being elected the Assistant State Secretary in 1997. She later worked with the union United Voice.

From 2007, Simone served as Assistant Secretary, and later Secretary, of Unions WA. There, she coordinated the Your Rights at Work Campaign against the Howard Government's 'Workchoices' reforms, and campaigned for more local content and local jobs during WA's mining boom. Simone has also worked with Yamatji Land and Sea Council, and as a producer with the ABC.

Simone holds degrees in History from the University of Melbourne and Media from Murdoch University.

Ben Wyatt is the Western Australian Treasurer, Minister for Finance, Energy and Aboriginal Affairs.

Ben commenced his study in Arts and Law at the University of Western Australia in 1992.

He undertook training as an officer in the Australian Army Reserves at the Royal Military College at Duntroon, graduating with his Commission in 1996.

After receiving a Rotary Ambassadorial scholarship, Ben completed his Masters at the London School of Economics and Political Science, graduating with Distinction in 2001. Upon his return to Perth, Ben continued his legal career in private practice and with the WA Department of Public Prosecutions.

Ben was elected to the Legislative Assembly to represent the electorate of Victoria Park after the resignation of former premier Geoff Gallop in 2006.

Between 2008 and 2016, Ben held a number of senior positions in the Shadow Cabinet, including as Shadow Treasurer and Shadow Minister for Federal State Relations, Aboriginal Affairs, Native Title and Government Accountability. He also served as Deputy Chair of the Public Accounts Committee.

Ben took on his current ministerial responsibilities on the election of the McGowan Government in March 2017.

In 2013 Emil moved to the role of Finance Planning and Strategy VP for the Eastern Hemisphere where he was accountable for helping to shape long term strategy and business plans for the Eastern Hemisphere Regions (AGT, North Africa, Asia Pacific) to support investment decision making and value generation.

In his most recent role as Commercial Vice President, Emil was responsible for leading commercial and business planning activities for BP across AGT region, North Africa and the Middle East.
