



Net Migration (by year of arrival)





Temporary visa categories and numbers

Population growth (2007 to 2017)



96 per cent are under the age of 50, compared to almost 67 per cent of the Australian population

Recommendations

Actions that can be taken immediately:

- Increasing transparency around the skilled occupation list.
- Aligning emerging labour trends to occupation codes.
- Creating a dedicated path for intra-company transfer of employees to Australia

Additional recommendations

- Better aligning the Skilling Australia Fund Levy to alleviate the skill shortages.
- Creating an independent committee to analyse and consult on the skilled occupation lists.
- A regular Productivity Commission review of the temporary skilled visa program.
- Moving the levy collection to the visa approval stage.
