




#### **GROSS STATE/DOMESTIC PRODUCT GROWTH** Financial Year, Annual % Change




#### WESTERN AUSTRALIA'S EXPORTS 12-Month Rolling Sum, Level and % Australia



#### WA'S EXPORTS, 12-MONTH ROLLING SUM By Destination, \$m




#### OUTPUT BY INDUSTRY Share of Factor Income, 2004-05



#### COMMODITY PRICE INDEX In Australian Dollars, Index (Period Average = 100)




#### VALUE OF WA MINERAL PRODUCTION **Calendar Years**



BUSINESS INVESTMENT BY SECTOR Western Australia, Quarterly, Original




#### ENGINEERING CONST. WORK YET TO BE DONE Western Australia, Quarterly Value, Current Prices




#### REAL PER CAPITA RETAIL SALES, QUARTERLY WA & Australia, Seasonally Adjusted, 2003-04 Prices




#### ESTABLISHED HOUSE PRICE GROWTH Western Australia and Australia, Annual % Change




WA RESIDENTIAL BUILDING WORK DONE By Stage of Production, Number, Quarterly




#### WA's UNEMPLOYMENT BY DURATION 12-Month Moving Average, % Labour Force




#### SKILLED VACANCIES, WA & AUSTRALIA Monthly, Trend, Index (November 1997 = 100)






#### **CRUDE OIL** West Texas Intermediate, Spot, Cushing




#### NET EXPORTS (VOLUME) Percentage Points Contribution to Growth





#### EMPLOYMENT GROWTH Financial Year, Annual % Change





#### GENERAL GOVERNMENT REVENUES Financial Year, Annual % Change




#### GENERAL GOVERNMENT EXPENSES Financial Year, Annual % Change






#### NET OPERATING BALANCE General Government Sector






#### REAL PER CAPITA OWN-PURPOSE EXPENSES General Government Sector







#### NET DEBT AS A SHARE OF REVENUE Total Non-Financial Public Sector
