


#### WA GROSS STATE PRODUCT Financial Year, Current Prices

## The strongest State economy in the nation


#### GROWTH IN REAL STATE FINAL DEMAND 4-Quarter Moving Average, % Change to March 2006







#### WA TOTAL ACTUAL CAPITAL SPEND Financial Year, Dollar Value






#### ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION WORK DONE (ANNUAL TOTALS)




#### ENGINEERING CONSTRUCTION WORK YET TO BE DONE, WESTERN AUSTRALIA
